About Tyne Rivers Trust

Tyne Rivers Trust (TRT) is a registered charity that works throughout the Tyne and Northumberland River catchments to protect and enhance the environment for the benefit of people who live in and visit the area. Our staff and volunteers undertake practical projects to tackle environmental problems, improve water quality, and enhance community wellbeing. We also work with local schools, community groups, and the public to educate them on the environment and inspire them to make positive changes.

In 2025, Tyne Rivers Trust expanded its remit to include the Northumberland Rivers catchment, extending the Trust's geographical reach from the River Tyne northwards to Berwick-upon-Tweed. This represents a significant step in TRT's growth, increasing both its environmental impact and the scale and complexity of its projects, partnerships and operations across the North East.

The Head of Philanthropy and Partnerships will lead the development and delivery of Tyne Rivers Trust's philanthropic income and strategic partnerships.

Working closely with the CEO, senior leadership team and colleagues across the Trust, you will cultivate high-value relationships, drive sustainable income and position TRT as a leading environmental charity across the Tyne and Northumberland catchments and beyond.

You will lead relationships with trusts and foundations, businesses, corporate partners, statutory bodies and major donors, while ensuring that fundraising and partnership strategies support TRT's mission, business plan and long-term sustainability.

As part of the Senior Leadership Team, you will provide strategic and operational leadership, ensuring opportunities are recognised and developed across the organisation.
